Rainey-McCullers School of the Arts is an official Steinway & Son's School that provides an academically rigorous curriculum in an intensive arts focused environment. Admission to Rainey-McCullers School of the Arts is highly competitive. Students who are admitted in the middle grades program (grades 6-8) enter on an arts exploratory basis. These students will select an arts focus area while participating in other arts area electives in addition to their Honors level core courses. Students admitted at the high school level (grades 9-12) will declare an arts area major in which they will enroll in two classes each school year within that arts area. High School students also have the option to enroll in Advance Placement (AP) courses.
